

Explore a unique architectural complex comprising Eileen Gray's Villa E-1027, Le Corbusier's Cabanon and Camping Units, and the Etoile de mer bar-restaurant!

Built at the start of the 20th century in an extraordinary setting, the complex also offers panoramic views of the coastline. Villa E-1027, by Eileen Gray and Jean Badovici, is as avant-garde a vision as it is a poetic one. Le Corbusier, meanwhile, left his mark on the site with his murals. Following his famous Cabanon, now a World Heritage site, he built 5 camping units here, one of which is open to the public.

DID YOU KNOW...?


In E-1027, the E stands for Eileen, the 10 for J, the 10th letter in the alphabet, the 2 for B and the 7 for G.


